On the November 3, 2026 ballot, you'll decide on Prop. 1, a Fire & EMS Property Tax Levy Lid Lift.

That's why a response time of 5 minutes or less is essential for saving lives.



GAPS IN COVERAGE

Areas of Longview are outside the 5-minute response window, leaving neighbors at risk.



RISING DEMAND

Emergency calls have nearly doubled since 2005, while staffing has remained largely unchanged.



PREPARE FOR TOMORROW

Longview is growing. We need the resources today to ensure we can protect our community tomorrow.

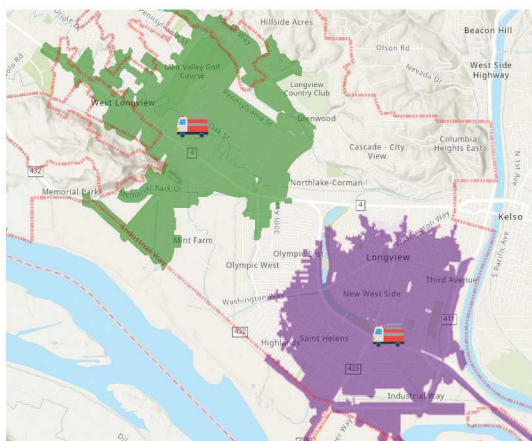

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CURRENT RESPONSE TIME COVERAGE

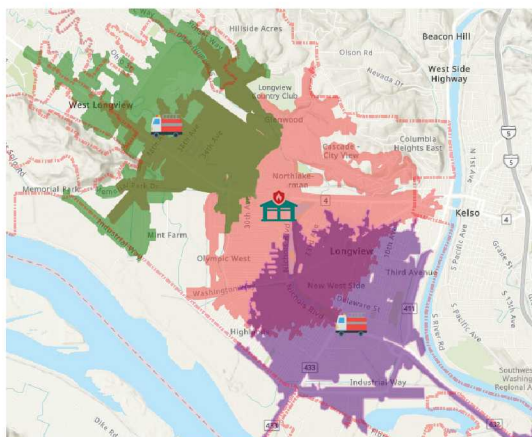
(with existing stations)

STATION #83

Building and staffing a new station in this area will close critical coverage gaps, improve response times, and strengthen emergency response citywide.
